NOVA Hope for Haiti is a 501c3 charitable corporation which was founded in 2005 to provide healthcare and health education in the rural southwest part of Haiti centering in the town of Cavaillon. We have been providing medical care in Haiti since 2002, mainly by conducting volunteer medical missions for 8 days once to twice per year. This care has served thousands of people and has saved lives, however it is not the quantum leap in child care that a year round clinic would provide.

Now in 2012, NOVA Hope for Haiti is making its biggest push to raise \$150,000.00 in order to build and staff a full-time pediatric clinic in Cavaillon. We have already purchased the land, created architectural drawings of the clinic with construction costs, and created a team of US doctors who will design our pediatric care programs and help interview and hire a Haitian doctor, nurse and administrator to run the clinic. 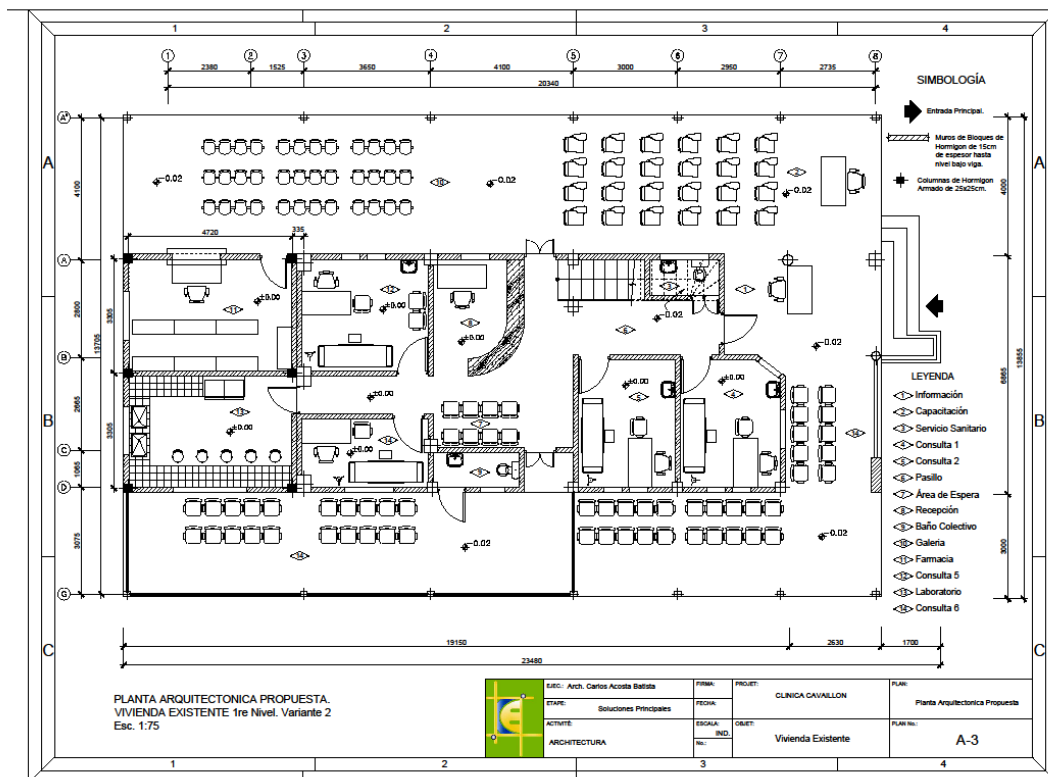
NOVA's future Pediatric Clinic



This is the Duverseau house. An old, well built farm house on 12 acres of land just minutes from the center of Cavaillon, Haiti. Cavaillon is the center of a rural area of over 100,000 people who have little to no access to medical care.

This house will be completely renovated in order to create a two story pediatric clinic. The first floor will be clinic space proper with 4 examining rooms, a pharmacy and a lab. The second floor will be a small apartment to provide housing for staff and thereby reduce some of the salary costs of some staff.

A large, covered porch will also be constructed on 3 sides of the house to create space for health and hygiene education as well as waiting room space. NOVA purchased this property in 2006.
